Psychological trauma – impacts on victims and witnesses

Episode summary

This episode focuses on the psychological impact of transport incidents, particularly on victims and witnesses who may suffer trauma such as PTSD.

Key topics

Psychological claims:

- People who suffer purely psychological injuries (without physical injury) may still be entitled to the TAC support.
- Entitlements include medical expenses, loss of earnings, and impairment lump sum claims, as discussed in episodes 3 and 4.

Case examples:

- The episode shares examples of successful psychological-only claims.

Trauma-informed approach:
